## SECTION 028003 - DISPOSAL OF NON-HAZARDOUS INDUSTRIAL-COMMERCIAL WASTE

### PART 1 - GENERAL

#### 1.1 REFERENCES

- A. 6 NYCRR - New York State Codes, Rules, and Regulations.

#### 1.2 DESCRIPTION

- A. The existing 1,000-gallon fuel oil storage tank, associated with the existing emergency generator scheduled for removal under this Contract, contains approximately 850 gallons of residual fuel oil. The Work of this Contract includes pumping out, removing, transporting, and disposing of the residual fuel oil, together with any associated tank-bottom sludge, water, and residue remaining in the tank, in accordance with all applicable governmental agency codes, rules, and regulations and the requirements of the receiving facility.

#### 1.3 SUBMITTALS

- A. Quality Control Submittals:

1. Detailed list of the codes, rules and regulations which are understood to govern the Work. This list must cite specific title, chapter, and section of the citation.
2. Listing of licenses or permits issued by government agencies authorizing the handling of the waste by the qualified Company, transporter, and operator of the disposal facility.
3. Waste characterization and waste determination for the tank contents. Prior to removal, characterize the tank contents as required by applicable codes, rules, and regulations and by the receiving facility, and submit the resulting characterization documentation together with the receiving facility's waste profile acceptance for the proposed disposition. If the characterization indicates that any portion of the tank contents is a hazardous waste, notify the Director's Representative immediately and do not proceed with removal or disposition of that material until directed by the Director's Representative.
4. Detailed step by step procedure indicating how the Work is to be accomplished. Procedure shall also include information for off-site Work, such as:
  - a. Method of disposal.
  - b. Owner and operator of the disposal facility.
  - c. Location of the disposal facility.
  - d. Method of transporting to the disposal facility.
5. Qualified Company Data:
  - a. Name, address, and telephone number.
  - b. Brochure explaining services offered.
  - c. Experience directly applicable to the required services.
  - d. Type and listing of equipment proposed to be used for the Work.

- B. Submittals for this section are subject to the re-evaluation fee identified in Article 4 of the General Conditions.
- C. Submittals shall be provided individually in the order in which they are specified and tabbed.

#### 1.4 QUALITY ASSURANCE

- A. Qualified Company: The Work shall be performed by a qualified Company having at least 3 years experience directly applicable to the services required.
- B. Pre-Work Conference: Before the Work of this Section is scheduled to commence, a conference will be held by the Director's Representative at the Site for the purpose of reviewing the Contract Documents, discussing requirements for the Work, and reviewing the Work procedures.

#### 1.5 PROJECT CONDITIONS

- A. Environmental Requirements:
  - 1. Comply with all applicable governmental agency codes, rules, and regulations for handling non-hazardous industrial, commercial and non-industrial waste.

### PART 2 - PRODUCTS

#### 2.1 MATERIALS FOR USE DURING DISPOSAL PROCEDURE

- A. Furnish materials which meet all applicable governmental agency codes, rules and regulations.

### PART 3 - EXECUTION

#### 3.1 PERFORMANCE

- A. Pump and remove all diesel fuel remaining in the existing 1,000-gallon fuel tank. Coordinate the Work with removal of the existing emergency generator and perform the Work in a manner that prevents spills or releases.
- B. Transport the removed fuel using an authorized transporter to a facility authorized to receive the material. Dispose of the fuel in accordance with all applicable governmental agency codes, rules, and regulations.
- C. Upon completion, submit disposal documentation confirming the quantity removed and the final disposition of the fuel, including transporter and receiving-facility records.
